

THE BRITISH SUPERKART RACING CLUB CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP REGULATIONS

2008 SEASON

1. SPORTING REGULATIONS - GENERAL

The British Superkart Racing Club Championships for Div. 1, F250 National, F250 National Superstocks, F125 Open & F210 National is administered by THE BRITISH SUPERKART RACING CLUB in accordance with the General Regulations of the Royal Automobile Club Motor Sport Association (incorporating the provisions of the Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Championship Regulations.

1.2 OFFICIALS

1.2.1 The Championship will be organised by THE BRITISH SUPERKART RACING CLUB Steering Committee

1.2.2 CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP STEWARDS.

1.3 COMPETITOR ELIGIBILITY

1.3.1 Drivers and Entrant/Drivers must be a fully paid up, card holding member of THE BRITISH SUPERKART RACING CLUB and in possession of a valid 2008 MSA National Kart Licence of the appropriate grade.

1.4 CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP ROUNDS

Club points will be awarded for each and every race within an event that a club member competes at even if it is not a feature event in his/her class. The minimum entry level to score club and attendance points will be 5 per class.

1.4.1 The Championship will Comprise of all events run by the BSRC and having at least two races per event. Each race will be a round of the championship and therefore a points scoring opportunity providing more than five competitors enter per class.

For 2008 drivers will count every round. i.e NO DROPPED SCORE

1.5 SCORING

1.5.1 Points will be awarded in each race as follows:-

40, 36, 34,32,30,28,26,24,22,20,18,16,14,12,10,8,6,4,2

1-4 Entries = NO PLACE POINTS

5 – 9 Entries = HALF POINTS

10 or More = FULL POINTS

All scores will count. There will be no dropped rounds.

1.5.2 In the event of a tie in points between two or more drivers the better-discarded results will be counted to resolve it. If A tie still exists the number of best places will be counted. Should neither of these methods be effective the driver who beats the most people will win i.e. total number of starters in qualifying events count for each driver involved in the tie, if still not resolved a count back of people beaten in each drivers discarded rounds to count. Should none of these methods be effective the Championship will be decided by method specified by organising clubs.

2. SPORTING REGULATIONS - JUDICIAL PROCEDURES

2.1 Rounds: In accordance with Section O of the 2008 MSA Yearbook.

2.2 Championship: In accordance with Section O of the 2008 MSA Yearbook.

2.3 **Awards** - A prize/trophy presentation will take place at each event to at least the first three in each class and drivers should attend to collect awards. If this is not possible another person may be asked to collect the award for the driver. If the award is not collected it may be disposed of as the club organising the event decides. Club Championship awards will be presented at a special end of season awards evening. The venue for which will be announced later.

3. TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

3.1 Will be the same as those for the MSA British Championship for F250 National, BSA Division 1 Superkart Championship, BSA F125 Open Championship and the F210 National Challenge.

The exceptions below however apply :-

Fuel - Club members taking part in a British or National Championship event run by the BSRC but not registered to score points in those National Championships can if they wish run MSA Regulation fuel instead of the Championship control fuel. If they have registered then they must use the control fuel.

Tyres - Club members who are not registered for a British F250 National Championship and the BSA F125 Open Championship are not required to mark tyres at BSRC run events.

3.2 **Transponders** - **AMB TranX 160 transponders** will be in use during the series and must be mounted upright (i.e. with 'R' clip at the top) as follows:- from the centre of the line of the front axle to the centre line of the transponder will be a minimum of 290mm towards the rear of the kart. Transponders must be mounted in accordance with the manufacturers recommendations
